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Victory of Donald Trump and the Future of Imran Khan

Introduction

The 2024 U.S. presidential election marked a defining moment in American politics. The fierce race between Republican Donald Trump and Democrat Kamala Harris saw Trump emerge victorious, securing 295 electoral votes and 73.5 million popular votes (50.7%). while Harris earned 226 electoral votes and 69.1 million popular votes (47.7%). Trump's successful campaign capitalized on his strong connection with his base, targeted voter engagement, and strategic messaging on key issues. Despite ongoing legal challenges and controversies surrounding his previous term, Trump's appeal to certain voter groups, particularly in critical swing states, proved decisive. This article delves into the various elements that contributed to Trump's victory, such as his policy positions, campaign tactics, and the pivotal issues that shaped voter decisions. It also discusses the implications of his second term on both domestic policies and global relations, as the U.S. braces for the consequences of another Trump presidency.

Candidates and **Parties**

Donald Trump: Republican Candidate and Key Political **Figure**

Donald Trump, having previously served as the 45th President of the United States, ran for a second term in 2024 with the Republican Party. His political platform was anchored in his "America First" ideology, which focused on strengthening the economy, curbing immigration, and ensuring U.S. sovereignty in global affairs. Meanwhile, Harris utilized platforms like Instagram and Twitter to mobilize younger voters and encourage early voting through digital campaigns.

Campaign Strategies

Harris's Focus on Policy Reform and Appealing to Diverse Voter Demographics

Harris's campaign centered on policy reform, focusing on healthcare access, climate action, and social justice. Her policy proposals included expanding the Affordable Care Act, pushing for a \$15 minimum wage, and tackling climate change through the implementation of the Green New Deal. Additionally, Harris's





team worked hard to engage minority voters, particularly African Americans, Latinos, and Asian Americans, who formed a significant portion of the Democratic electorate.

While Harris focused on unity and progress, she faced significant challenges in rallying the Democratic base. Many progressive voters, especially in the aftermath of the 2020 election, felt disillusioned by the lack of bold action on certain issues. Trump consistently emphasized law and order, portraying his administration as a protector of public safety. This approach appealed to many voters who were concerned about rising crime rates but alienated others who sought broader social reforms in the wake of police violence against Black Americans.

Legal Challenges and Controversies



s Donald Trump's apparent victory in recent U.S. presidential election awaits official confirmation, a wave of cautious optimism has spread among supporters of Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) Chairman and former Prime Minister Imran Khan. Many within the PTI and Pakistan's diaspora community are speculating on whether Trump's administration might advocate for Khan's release from prison, given the rapport the two leaders shared during Trump's previous term. However, while some hold out hope, others recognize that Trump's focus may ultimately lie elsewhere.

Trump's Victory Ignites Speculation in Pakistan

For Khan's supporters, Trump's return represents potential leverage in their ongoing struggle to secure Khan's freedom. The stakes are high following a severe crackdown on PTI by the Pakistani government and with general elections in Pakistan

approaching in February. Trump's win, some PTI supporters believe, could be a turning point, or at the very least, a spotlight on the party's grievances, including allegations of political repression.

Still, it's uncertain whether Trump would actively intervene in Pakistan's internal politics, even as president. Imran Khan's situation, while significant for many Pakistanis, may not be a priority for Trump. The former U.S. president's current foreign policy concerns, especially regarding issues involving key allies like India, could override any inclination to intervene in Pakistan's political landscape.

PTI's "Good Friend" Trump: A History of **Amicable Ties**

During his tenure, Imran Khan developed a cooperative relationship with Trump, with the two leaders meeting multiple times, including at the White House. The

meetings were cordial, with Trump even describing Khan as a "good friend." This close relationship gave rise to expectations that Trump would be more sympathetic to Khan's plight than the Biden administration, which PTI leaders have often criticized for its perceived "negativity" toward Pakistan. The Biden administration's alleged involvement in Khan's ouster has only fueled these sentiments, with many PTI supporters viewing Trump as a potential ally in their campaign for Khan's release.

However, foreign policy experts like Michael Kugelman from the Wilson Center suggest a more pragmatic interpretation of Trump's relationship with Khan. Kugelman argues that Trump's outreach to Khan was likely motivated by his interest in engaging the Taliban and facilitating U.S. withdrawal from Afghanistan. The Trump administration's dealings with Pakistan were, therefore, less about personal loyalty and more about strategic interests.



Trump's recent campaign silence on Khan's predicament could reflect this. Kugelman's assessment suggests that Trump, focused on other pressing issues, may not prioritize Khan's situation in his foreign policy.

Khawaja Asif's Perspective: Pakistan's **Government Remains** Unmoved

The Pakistani government, however, appears unperturbed by Trump's victory. Speaking in Islamabad, Defence Minister Khawaja Asif stated that the administration does not anticipate Trump intervening in Khan's case. Asif expressed skepticism over any potential U.S. pressure for Khan's release, adding that Pakistan would wait 15 to 20 days to observe any definitive stance Trump might take once in office.

According to Asif, the government remains firm in its stance, unconcerned by external influence on its domestic policies. He reiterated that Pakistan is more focused on securing its internal stability ahead of the elections rather than heeding external demands.

PTI Leaders' Take: A Mixture of Hope and Realism

PTI leaders have shared a mixed response to Trump's victory. While some members see it as a positive development that could potentially benefit Khan, others have been quick to downplay any immediate expectations. PTI leader Raoof Hasan commented that the party had not placed its hopes on Trump's return to power as a means of securing Khan's release, noting that PTI's strategy rests primarily on domestic avenues, such as the judiciary, parliamentary lobbying, and public protests.

Hasan's comments reflect a sentiment of tempered optimism within PTI ranks. He stressed that while PTI supporters might appreciate Trump's diplomatic goodwill, the party's official strategy remains grounded in Pakistan's institutions. He added that PTI's interactions with Pakistan's military establishment have been largely routine, denying any ongoing discussions with the establishment regarding Khan's release.

In a recent interview, PTI leader Zulfi Bukhari revealed his intention to raise the issue of the alleged mistreatment of Imran Khan with the incoming Trump administration. However, Imran Khan has expressed doubt that the new U.S. government will intervene or help secure his release. Speaking to reporters at Adiala Jail, Khan stated, "I hope Trump will remain neutral and not follow the path of Joe Biden. The issue of my release will be resolved within Pakistan, not through the United States."

Bukhari further emphasized his plans to personally visit Washington to meet with Ivanka, Jared, and members of their team. He intends to discuss the alleged injustices faced by Khan and his party, along with broader issues like human rights, democratic values, and the rule of law in Pakistan once Trump assumes office.

Bukhari also claimed that Trump had previously voiced concerns regarding Khan's legal challenges. Meanwhile, former PTI leader Fawad Chaudhry echoed similar sentiments, stating that the U.S. has already expressed its concerns over the "unfair trials" faced by Khan. Chaudhry expressed confidence that Trump would advocate for Khan's release, suggesting that the President-elect would not ignore congressional resolutions on the matter.

Chaudhry also pointed out that members of the PML-N party had been deleting old social media posts after Trump's victory, fearing the implications of his return to office. He reiterated his hope that the Pakistani government would uphold its constitutional and international human rights commitments, respecting the will of the people.

Opposition leader Omar Ayub congratulated Trump and Vice President JD Vance on their electoral win, expressing hope that their leadership would foster stronger ties between the people of Pakistan and the United States.

In response to Defence Minister Khawaja Asif's statement that some believed it was only a matter of time before the U.S. would intervene to secure Khan's release. PTI leader Asad Qaiser dismissed the remarks, stating, "Asif is at an age where his comments should not be taken seriously."

Foreign Office spokesperson Mumtaz Zahra Baloch also addressed the issue. clarifying that claims of foreign interference in Pakistan's internal affairs are unfounded. Qaiser concluded by reiterating that the PTI remains focused on its internal struggle, emphasizing that the party will not allow any foreign interference in Pakistan's sovereignty.

Imran Khan's Message: "Positivity" in Trump's

From prison, Imran Khan himself has expressed measured optimism regarding Trump's return, according to PTI leader Ali Muhammad Khan. Ali shared that Imran sees Trump's win as potentially easing the "negativity" toward Pakistan that he attributes to the Biden administration's stance. The PTI has long alleged that the Biden administration, in its preference for political stability, maintained a "hostile" posture towards Khan's tenure, leading to interference in Pakistan's domestic affairs.

In this context, Khan's supporters abroad have celebrated Trump's election victory as a potential opening for reestablishing favorable relations with the U.S. For the PTI, Trump's return represents an opportunity to foster U.S.-Pakistan relations rooted in mutual respect for democracy, peace, and human rights. As Khan himself reportedly noted, he hopes Trump's leadership will encourage a more balanced U.S. policy in the region.

The Diaspora's Role: An Overseas Support Network

Pakistani Americans and other overseas supporters of Imran Khan play a crucial role in keeping international attention on his situation. This diaspora community, vocal in its advocacy, has long campaigned for Khan's release and frequently raises



issues related to Pakistan's political climate on global platforms. For these supporters, Trump's re-election is seen as a potential diplomatic lever, one that might facilitate international pressure on Pakistan's government to reconsider its stance on PTI and Khan.

Many overseas PTI supporters also see Trump's administration as a counterbalance to what they perceive as a biased approach under Biden. These supporters believe that with Trump in the White House, there may be renewed international interest in Pakistan's political developments, particularly with human rights, political repression, and democratic norms.

Challenges Ahead: The Road to Imran Khan's Release

Despite Trump's return, Khan's release faces substantial obstacles. The Pakistani government's recent crackdown on PTI has been extensive, with arrests, legal restrictions, and aggressive monitoring of party activities. Khan's imprisonment stems from convictions in multiple cases, part of what PTI leaders argue is a coordinated effort to undermine their political standing ahead of the general elections.

While Trump's administration could potentially highlight concerns over Khan's treatment, Pakistani analysts caution that any such intervention might yield limited results. Given the legal proceedings underway in Pakistan, any attempts by foreign powers to intervene in Khan's case would likely be met with resistance from Pakistan's judiciary and government institutions. The administration remains adamant that its judicial process operates independently of external influence, and any foreign input on the matter might be viewed as undue interference.

A Complex Diplomatic Landscape: U.S. Interests in South Asia

Ultimately, Trump's foreign policy, even if sympathetic to Khan's plight, would have to account for the broader dynamics of U.S.-South Asia relations. The U.S. has significant interests in the region, with India as a key ally and China as a regional

competitor. Trump has previously shown an inclination toward strengthening the U.S.-India partnership, a stance that aligns with strategic priorities.

In recent weeks, Trump has taken to his platform, Truth Social, to praise the U.S.-India relationship and address issues related to religious freedoms in South Asia. Notably, he condemned what he described as "total chaos" in Bangladesh regarding the treatment of religious minorities. However, his silence on Khan's situation has left some PTI supporters disappointed, leading to doubts about whether Pakistan will figure prominently in Trump's agenda.

Kugelman's analysis, supported Trump's recent statements, suggests that India will likely remain a focal point of Trump's South Asia policy. Given this, any diplomatic gestures from Trump towards Pakistan may be limited to general statements on human rights rather than specific calls for Khan's release.

Raoof Hasan emphasized that PTI's advocacy efforts are ongoing and will persist independently of U.S. political developments. The party's parliamentary group has also denied any significant negotiations with the Pakistani establishment regarding Khan's case, underscoring its focus on legal recourse within Pakistan. This balanced approach reflects a realistic assessment of PTI's options in the current political climate.

Conclusion: Cautious Optimism and Realistic **Expectations**

While Trump's return to the White House has generated speculation among PTI supporters, the prospects intervention in Khan's case remain uncertain. Trump's administration may choose to champion democracy and human



Looking Ahead: PTI's Domestic and International Strategy

For PTI, the path forward remains challenging, but party leaders appear resolved to pursue both domestic and international avenues for Khan's release. Imran Khan's Final Call: A Nationwide Protest on November 24

Introduction

Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) Chairman Imran Khan, once a celebrated cricket star turned politician, has once again taken center stage in the political turmoil of Pakistan. Looking Ahead: The Political Future of PTI and Imran Khan



Arab and Muslim Leaders Gather in Riyadh for **Urgent Summit on Gaza and Lebanon Crises**

n a moment of profound diplomatic significance, leaders from over 50 Arab and Muslim-majority nations gathered in Riyadh for an urgent summit aimed at addressing the escalating crises in Gaza and southern Lebanon. This extraordinary meeting, organized under the leadership of Saudi Arabia, sought to forge a united response to the recent cycle of violence between Israel and Palestinian forces and to address the humanitarian toll in Gaza, where thousands have been killed and displaced amid Israel's retaliatory strikes. The summit also highlighted the intensifying conflict in Lebanon, where Hezbollah forces, supported by Iran, continue to clash with Israeli forces along Lebanon's southern border.

approach, reiterated the Kingdom's firm stance in support of Palestinian rights while also emphasizing the need for regional stability. Turkey's President Recep Tayyip Erdogan used his platform at the summit to call for a robust international response to Israel's actions. Erdogan, who has long positioned Turkey as a champion of Palestinian rights, issued one of the summit's strongest rebukes of Israel, accusing it of war crimes and urging global leaders to take a firmer stance against what he described as disproportionate aggression.

Pakistan's Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif took a similarly resolute stance, condemning the ongoing military actions and expressing Pakistan's unequivocal support for the Palestinian people. Highlighting Pakistan's historic ties to the Palestinian cause, Sharif urged the United Nations to intervene and ensure the protection of civilians. His comments reflected a widespread sentiment shared by other Muslim-majority nations, where public outrage over the situation in Gaza has continued to mount.

Meanwhile. Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas used the platform to call for renewed international focus on the two-state solution. Abbas, whose leadership has faced growing challenges from within Palestine, urged Muslim nations to not only condemn Israel's actions but to push for a viable path toward Palestinian statehood.

population. The Riyadh summit's participants underscored the need for diplomatic solutions to prevent Lebanon from becoming another battlefield. Several countries. including Jordan and Egypt, pledged support for diplomatic initiatives to de-escalate tensions in Lebanon, while also emphasizing the need for greater coordination with international actors to avoid further instability.

A recurring theme throughout the summit was the need to reestablish commitment to

Hezbollah, an Iran-backed Shia militant group with significant political sway in Lebanon, has ramped up its military presence along the Israeli border. This escalation poses a direct threat not only to Israel but to Lebanon's fragile stability, which has already been tested by economic collapse and internal political turmoil.

At the summit, Lebanese officials expressed grave concerns over the potential repercussions of an all-out war with Israel, warning that the conflict could have devastating effects on Lebanon's already vulnerable

Saudi Arabia, which has previously shown openness to engaging in normalization talks with Israel, reiterated that its commitment to peace is contingent upon the establishment of a Palestinian state. Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman emphasized that normalization with Israel is not possible without meaningful progress on Palestinian statehood. The Saudi stance is a pivotal signal to other regional players, many of whom view the Kingdom's

position as critical in shaping broader Arab and Muslim support for Palestine.

International Intervention and Calls for Accountability

With mounting civilian casualties and the worsening humanitarian crisis, summit attendees urged the United Nations and other international bodies to hold Israel accountable for its actions. Several leaders proposed taking the issue to the International Court of Justice, advocating for an investigation into potential human rights violations and war crimes. The call for accountability was echoed by representatives from Pakistan, Iran, and Turkey, who stressed that the international community has a moral obligation to prevent further loss of civilian lives.

In a joint statement, the summit participants called on the United Nations Security Council to take decisive action. This includrecommendations for economic sanctions on Israel and the imposition of arms embargoes to restrict military actions. These suggestions underscored the frustration within the Arab and Muslim world regarding what many perceive as an unequal application of international law. Summit participants argued that selective enforcement of international norms only deepens the grievances fueling regional unrest.

Prospects for Peace: A United Stand with Complex Challenges

As the summit concluded, leaders reaffirmed their commitment to the Palestinian cause while acknowledging the challenging path forward. The Rivadh summit demonstrated a rare moment of unity among Arab and Muslim nations, whose leaders pledged to support Palestine both diplomatically and financially. Saudi Arabia announced a new humanitarian aid package for Gaza, while Turkey pledged to send medical supplies and infrastructure support to assist with immediate recovery efforts.

Despite the symbolic show of unity, the summit underscored the deep-rooted complexities of the Israeli Palestinian conflict and the broader Arab-Israeli divide. While the Rivadh summit succeeded in consolidating regional support for Gaza, the path to a lasting peace remains fraught with obstacles. Divisions within the Palestinian leadership, Iran's role in Lebanon, and Israel's firm stance against Hamas all complicate prospects for progress. However, the summit served as a crucial platform for Arab and Muslim leaders to present a united front, reaffirming their commitment to the Palestinian cause and signaling their readiness to seek international support for peace efforts.

Saudi Cabinet Reaffirms Support for Palestine, Lebanon at Arab-Muslim Summit

The Saudi Cabinet, led by Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, convened in Riyadh on Tuesday to assess recent high-level summits and international engagements.

A primary focus was the review of the recent Arab and Islamic summit held in Riyadh on Monday, alongside discussions from the crown prince's meetings with various world leaders. The cabinet praised summit's outcomes, particularly welcoming the signing of the Tripartite Mechanism Document to Support Palestine — a joint initiative of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation, the Arab League, and the African Union Commis-

Reaffirming its support for the Palestinian and Lebanese people amid the severe humanitarian impact of ongoing Israeli military actions, the cabinet urged the global community to join an international coalition backing the two-state solution. This initiative, spearheaded this year by the Arab-Islamic Ministerial Committee under Saudi leadership, is supported by the European Union and Norway.

During the session, the crown prince



briefed the cabinet on recent discussions with Iran's President Masoud Pezeshkian. Japanese Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba, and a phone call with U.S. President-elect Donald Trump.

The minister of media highlighted the cabinet's appreciation for Saudi Arabia's Arab Week at UNESCO, held at the UN headquarters in Paris, as a means to enhance cultural dialogue and foster understanding among diverse communities.

On domestic matters, council members praised the reception of the Saudi medical team that achieved the world's first full robotic heart transplant. The cabinet also celebrated the success of the 10th Beban 24 Forum in Riyadh, which generated agreements and initiatives valued at over SR35.4 billion (\$9.42 billion) to boost entrepreneurship and support small and medium enterprises in contributing to the national GDP.

Moving Forward: The Role of Arab Nations in Shaping Regional **Stability**

The Riyadh summit may mark a turning point in how the Arab and Muslim world approaches the Israeli Palestinian conflict. With regional heavyweights like Saudi Arabia and Turkey at the forefront, the summit demonstrated that the Palestinian



cause remains a central issue in Arab political discourse. It also highlighted the evolving role of Arab nations in shaping a more assertive and independent foreign policy, one that prioritizes humanitarian concerns and aligns with global norms.

Trump Raaj _ The New World Order

Despite reconciliatory tones; fears remain

s the results poured in across the United States, the Republican presidential candidate and one-time President of the United States Donald Trump was again elevated to the post of leading the United States or rather leading world affairs by the American electorate. With the American system allowing roughly two months for the transition from one administration to the succeeding one; it is all clear for the American polity within and the world at large; that it is going to be a new world; even much before the formal swearing-in on January 20, 2025.

There has been much talk and gossip about how the new administration will react to world issues at this stage; however, it goes without saying that there are definitely few upsets and few expectations with Republicans virtually taking the center stage of this world. To begin with, there has been much enthusiasm amongst the political divide that the arrival of Trump will auger return from the political wilderness of certain figures in Pakistan.

The political realities suggest otherwise. Towards that count; it is important to observe that despite being a compliant left-wing politician Bhutto; did not disturb the Pentagon arrangements like CENTO and SEATO when in power; the United States for the sake of its interests preferred a military dictator. Rather it allowed the dictator to physically eliminate Bhutto. Likewise, when the Afghan war was closing down and there were 'winds of change' on board a "Lockheed Hercules" military transport, the republican administration under the senior Bush did not put all the eggs in the popular leader Benazir Bhutto basket; rather it tactically saved the heads of the previous administration through various assurances. It would not be out of context to say that the government BB inherited was something which prompted the founder of the Nation to use the term 'moth eaten' in 1948 during his own circumstances and observations.

The new man in Washington D.C might precipitate a breathing space for the 'prisoner'; but to expect a complete regime change will be asking for too much. Apart from that; the geo political scenario forces global actors to depend more on militaries than the popular political movements to get their work done. Towards that count the militaries in South Asia have proved themselves to be completely in line with PENTAGON

Treading the geo political space in its entirety, the biggest upset seems to be for the Iranian reformists as well as for the mainstream state. The Iranian reform group practically led by the foreign minister of the Rouhani administration Jawad Zarif was hoping that Democrats would manage things to the point where the reformist only viable project JCPOA will be restarted. Towards that goal, the reformist President, foreign minister, and Zarif were more concerned about securing their political fortunes than the geo political interests of the state they were supposedly representing.

As things stand, JCPOA has no chance to

be restarted anytime now. Rather, despite good words of reconciliation by the president-elect there are fair chances that the days of Trump's crippling sanctions might return. The fears are founded on credible grounds. Firstly, the Trump administration last time was a firm supporter of the Abraham Accords, which in simple words means recognition of Israel and submission to the dictates of the unipolar world. The Hamas incursion into the occupied territory on October 7, 2023, in a spectacular way aimed at breaking the stalemate.

For obvious reasons, after Biden, Trump will stand behind Netanyahu with even more force to get the job done; which means wiping out the resistance for all times to come. Towards that count, they have enough local players to support. Hamas will be crippled militarily, followed by last rites with the help of Egyptian and Jordanian military structures; not to forget the fund's investment from sheikhdoms led by Saudi Arabia. Hezbollah will be militarily decapitated and Lebanese political players like Druze and Maronites will be encouraged to go for legislation aimed at disarming Hezbollah.

Secondly, during much of 2024, Iran has

emerged as the greatest stumbling block to the Abraham Accords, helping the resistance as well as launching two strikes, despite political divisions at home. The crippling sanctions will help the United States and Israel to stab the center of resistance from within. The disgruntled Iranians and the reform movement might be the forces that will make the job easy for the United States to get the job done.

If the current stalemate of Iran doing nothing to deter IDF continues, emboldening the latter to harm the resistance even till the January 20, 2025 time; than the combined US and IDF onslaught will be a reality. Even now, when the affairs were being run by an indecisive Biden administration, the US AWACS provided critical intelligence to the IDF for eliminating the Hezbollah cadres. Likewise, the refueling of IDF jets over Iraq was take care off. The first week of November saw B-52 bombers, F-16 and F-15 jets being transferred to the Gulf based bases, in a clear sign of support for the IDF. How things will unfold, the on-ground events in the Middle East and especially within Iran will determine.

Coming to South Asia, given the fact that Indians have got along with the Trump administration quite well, there is fair chance that the military and economic ties will be strengthened with the Pakistani military left in the lurch. With practically Saudi Arabia the only political and economic supporter of the Pakistani political and military elite, the new world practically does not offer much more for Pakistan than the Urdu proverb "working on old take home".

The heralding of the new world order managed by the US military establishment like some third world countries is writ large on the US Department of Defence memorandum for the joint forces dated November 6, 2024. The language demonstrates the lurking guilt of bringing an impulsive man on center stage to get things done.

The world of tomorrow can unpredictable. No miracles can he expected from the anti-Abraham Accord countries in the coming days; however, as the attrition is expected to continue things might touch the boiling point where all the players might be tuned towards thinking in a do or die mode. Conclusively; war, strife, and economic meltdown due to the first two factors can push the triggering buttons to the limits, where there might not be a point of return.



What Does Hezbollah's New Leader Mean for Lebanon, Iran, and the Region?

ezbollah's deputy secretary general, Sheikh Naim Qassem, who has been a prominent figure in the Iran-backed group for over 30 years, was elected as its head on Tuesday.

In a televised address from an undisclosed location on October 8. Oassem stated that the conflict with Israel was a "war about who cries first." asserting that Hezbollah would not be the first to do so. He claimed the group's capabilities remain intact despite suffering "painful blows" from Israel. Notably, he expressed support for efforts by parliament speaker Nabih Berri-a Hezbollah ally-to secure a ceasefire, marking the first time he omitted mentioning a Gaza truce deal as a precondition for halting hostilities against Israel.

Qassem's 30-minute speech followed the suspected targeting of senior Hezbollah figure Hashem Safieddine in an Israeli strike and came 11 days after the death of Hezbollah's secretary general, Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah, which was confirmed by the group on October 23.

Qassem was appointed deputy chief in 1991 by the then-secretary general Abbas al-Musawi, who was killed by an Israeli helicopter strike the following year. He remained in his position when Nasrallah took over and has long served as a leading spokesperson for Hezbollah, frequently engaging with international media amid ongoing cross-border hostilities with Israel.

His October 8 address was his second since tensions escalated between Hezbollah and Israel in September, and he was the first member of Hezbollah's top leadership to speak publicly after Nasrallah's killing in an Israeli airstrike on September 27. On September 30, Oassem stated that Hezbollah would choose a successor to Nasrallah "at the earliest opportunity" and vowed to continue fighting Israel in solidarity with Palestinians, acknowledging that the struggle may be prolonged.

Born in 1953 in Beirut to a family from southern Lebanon, Qassem's political



activism began with the Shi'ite Amal Movement. He left the group in 1979 following Iran's Islamic Revolution, which significantly influenced many young Lebanese Shi'ite activists. He participated in discussions that led to the formation of Hezbollah, established with support from Iran's Revolutionary Guards in response to the 1982 Israeli invasion of Lebanon.

Since Hezbollah first contested parliamentary elections in 1992, Qassem has been the general coordinator of its election campaigns. In 2005, he published a history of Hezbollah, offering a rare insider's perspective on the organization. Unlike Nasrallah and Safieddine, who wear black turbans indicating their descent from the Prophet Muhammad, Qassem wears a white turban.

Hezbollah's New Leader: Implications for Lebanon, Iran, and the Region

For the second time in as many months, Hezbollah has been forced to appoint a new leader after Israel's targeted strikes killed its two previous leaders. Secretary-General Hassan Nasrallah died in September, followed by his deputy, Hashem Safieddine, just days after being named Nasrallah's successor.

The latest appointment, Naim Qassem, marks a significant shift but also underscores the challenges Hezbollah faces in the wake of these devastating losses. His ascension to Secretary-General appears more about ensuring internal stability within the group rather than signaling a shift in Hezbollah's overall direction. However, his appointment carries considerable implications not only for Lebanon but also for Iran and the broader Middle East region.

Stress Test for Hezbollah's Survival

Hezbollah's resilience has been put to the test by a series of catastrophic blows from Israeli airstrikes over recent months. especially following Israel's expansion of military operations against Gaza. Hezbollah has long positioned itself as a staunch supporter of the Palestinian resistance, earning it popularity among many Arabs.

However, its direct involvement in the conflict has come at a severe cost, particularly after Israel's air raids decimated key figures within the organization's leadership.

The killing of top figures like Nasrallah and Safieddine has raised doubts about Hezbollah's future and its ability to maintain control. Qassem's appointment, while significant, reflects the movement's struggle to maintain cohesion amidst such losses. As a known figure within Hezbollah, his leadership does not represent a radical shift in strategy but rather a necessary step to stabilize the organization. His "populist" image, however, has raised questions about his readiness to lead Hezbollah during such precarious times.

The fact that Hezbollah has been on the defensive after a series of Israeli attacks—particularly those targeting its senior leadership-highlights the critical moment the group finds itself in. Despite Hezbollah's attempts to engage in limited conflict with Israel, the escalation of violence and the deaths of its top leaders have made it clear that the movement's survival is at stake.

Escalating Conflict with Israel and Iranian Intervention

Hezbollah's strategy of engaging Israel in a limited capacity amidst the ongoing Gaza conflict quickly backfired. Israel's military response has surpassed expected levels, compelling Hezbollah to adapt to a far more intense and aggressive conflict than originally anticipated. The result was a wave of targeted assassinations against the group's leadership, weakening its ability to operate effectively.

This unprecedented escalation led Iran, Hezbollah's primary benefactor, to reconsider its approach. Initially, Iran had opted to delay its direct military response after the assassination of Ismail Haniyeh in Tehran in July. However, realizing that Israel's campaign threatened to undermine Hezbollah's operational capacity, Iran decided to step in decisively.

Iran's leadership decided to intervene directly to preserve Hezbollah as a critical ally. Two key strategies emerged: Iranian bombings deep within Israeli territory and

restructuring Hezbollah's leadership under the guidance of Iran's Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC).

Following the assassination of Hezbollah's leaders in September, Iran's Quds Force commander Esmail Qaani traveled to Lebanon to oversee the reorganization of Hezbollah. His mission was to ensure that the group's military capabilities remained intact, enabling it to continue confronting Israel and leveraging the momentum from Iran's broader regional strategy. Within just a few days, Qaani had restored Hezbollah's leadership structure, bringing the group back under Iran's direct supervision and aligning its objectives more closely with Tehran's interests.

Qassem's Appointment: Iran's Influence and Hezbollah's Future

Qassem's elevation to Secretary-General is a direct consequence of these developments and underscores Iran's pivotal role in Hezbollah's survival and its ongoing military strategy. His appointment has not only stabilized the group but also further integrated it into Iran's broader regional ambitions.

As Hezbollah's new leader, Qassem inherits a party that is both under immense pressure from Israeli aggression and reliant on Iranian backing to maintain its relevance. His leadership will be closely monitored, as it comes at a time of growing tension between Hezbollah and Israel, as well as heightened Iranian involvement in the group's operations. His appointment marks not just a reshuffling of leadership but a recalibration of Hezbollah's strategy under influence, potentially shaping the course of the broader regional conflict in the coming months.

With Hezbollah now more directly aligned with Iran's strategic goals, the group's role in the Middle East, particularly in relation to Israel and the Palestinian cause, will likely evolve. The success or failure of Qassem's leadership, alongside the ongoing regional challenges, will significantly impact the future trajectory of both Hezbollah and Iran's influence in Lebanon and beyond.

RECENT DESTRUCTION IN **GAZA AND LEBANON BY** ISRAELI VIOLENT AIR **STRIKES**

Israeli airstrikes killed dozens of people in Lebanon and Gaza on Sunday, including 13 children, as part of ongoing military operations ahead of a US-imposed deadline to improve aid access to Gaza.

In Gaza, rescuers reported that Israeli strikes killed 30 people in the northern region, with 13 of them being children. The first strike, which targeted a house in Jabalia, killed at least 25 people, including the children, and left more than 30 others wounded, according to Gaza's civil defense agency. Abdullah al-Najjar, a relative of those killed, described the scene as horrific. with bodies "torn apart" following the explosion at the Alloush family home.

Israel's military operations, which began on October 6, have been focused on preventing Hamas from reorganizing in the northern part of Gaza, which the UN has called "under siege." Israel's military claimed the airstrike targeted "infrastructure" being used by militants, posing a threat to Israeli forces.

Another attack in Gaza City's Sabra neighborhood killed five more people. The Israeli airstrikes have been met with increasing international pressure, particularly from Washington, which set a deadline this week for Israel to allow more aid into Gaza or risk cuts to US military support. Meanwhile, in Lebanon, at least 38 people were killed by Israeli strikes, with 23 deaths reported from a raid north of Beirut. A strike on the village of Almat in the Jbeil district, located outside Hezbollah's strongholds, killed 23 people, including seven children. The strike occurred shortly after a Hezbollah member visited the house, and he was later confirmed dead from his injuries.

Footage from the scene showed rescuers digging through the rubble of destroyed homes, pulling out bodies wrapped in blankets and using excavators to move the debris. These attacks are part of Israel's broader military operation in Gaza and Lebanon, with escalating violence threatening to spread further across the region.

Controversy surrounding North Korean troops deployment in Russia to fight against Ukraine

orth Korean soldiers have deployed into combat in Russia's Kursk Oblast alongside Russian forces. Ukraine's Main Military Intelligence Directorate (GUR) reported on October 24 that the first units of North Korean personnel deployed to Kursk Oblast on October 23, following a few weeks of training at various military bases in Russia's Primorsky and Khabarovsk krais, Amur Oblast, and the Republic of Buryatia. The GUR's October 24 statement follows recent South Korean and Ukrainian intelligence reports warning of the rapid deployment and training of tens of thousands of North Korean soldiers in Russia's Far East and mounting visual evidence of North Korean troops training and assembling at Russian military bases.

South Korea's National Intelligence Service (NIS) reported on October 18 that North Korea deployed a first wave of approximately 1,500 special forces personnel to Russia between October 8 and October 13, sharing satellite imagery purportedly showing North Korean soldiers gathering at Russian military facilities in Ussuriysk, Krai Primorsky and Khabarovsk, Khabarovsk Krai. South Korea's Yonhap News reported on October 18 that the NIS assessed after a closed-door emergency security meeting with South Korean President Yoon Suk-yeol that North Korea decided to send four brigades totaling 12,000 personnel to Russia, and the NIS warned on October 25 that a second wave of 1,500 personnel will soon depart for Russia.

Ukraine's Center for Strategic Communications released footage on October 18 reportedly showing North Korean troops receiving their equipment at the Sergeevka training ground in Primorsky Krai, and additional social media footage published in subsequent days purportedly showed North Korean troops arriving and training at military bases in eastern Russia. GUR Head Lieutenant General Kyrylo Budanov noted to the Economist on October 22 that the total North Korean contingent of 12,000 personnel includes 500 officers and three

generals. The Pentagon and the White House confirmed on October 23 that the US has evidence that thousands of North Korean soldiers have deployed to Russia. Russian President Vladimir Putin failed to deny the reports on October 24, and in fact appears to have obliquely affirmed them, responding to a media question on October 24 about satellite imagery purportedly of North Korean troops at Russian training grounds, remarking that "photos are a serious thing" and "reflect something."

North Korea and Russia have somewhat diverged in their official responses to news of North Korea joining the war on Russia's behalf. North Korea has so far denied all evidence outright. A North Korean representative to the United Nations General Assembly's First Committee on Disarmament and International Security dismissed reports on October 21 of North Korean troops in Russia as "groundless stereotyped rumors aimed at smearing the image of North Korea and undermining the legitimate, friendly, and cooperative

relations" between Russia and North Korea. North Korean Vice Foreign Minister Kim Jong-gyu told North Korean state-controlled Korean Central News Agency (KCNA) on October 25 that news about North Korean troops in Russia is all "rumors," but that any potential deployment of North Korean troops to Russia would be "in accordance with international law." Kremlin officials have attempted to claim that any cooperation between Russia and North Korea is legitimate and not aimed at other states but have not explicitly denied the reports. The Kremlin in particular has repeatedly emphasized the supposed legality of Russia's cooperation with North Korea, likely in order to manage relations with South Korea and prevent Seoul from directly sending direct military aid to Ukraine. North Korea's more explicit denial may reflect a desire to avoid additional or increased international sanctions against Pyongyang.

The evolution of Russia-North Korea relations, 2022 to present

The growing requirements on Russia's ability to sustain its war in Ukraine have opened new avenues for cooperation between Moscow and Pyongyang. The Soviet Union was the first country to recognize North Korea in 1948 and supported North Korea during the Korean War. The Soviet Union continued to back North Korea economically and militarily throughout the 1960s, but Communist Party General Secretary Mikhail Gorbachev began opening to South Korea diplomatically in the 1980s. The Soviet Union established diplomatic relations with South Korea in 1990, driving a further wedge between Moscow and Pyongyang. Russian President Vladimir Putin attempted to re-establish a more solid relationship with North Korea upon his accession to the presidency in the early 2000s and visited Kim Jong-il in Pyongyang in 2000, framing his outreach as a recognition of the common anti-Western values that both Russia and North Korea share. Russia supported United Nations Security Council (UNSC) sanctions against North Korea over North Korean nuclear weapons and missile programs between 2006 to 2017 but

has largely reversed course since the start of the war in 2022

South Korea is considering deployment of its troops in Ukraine

The recent deployment of North Korean troops to Russia, reported by South Korean intelligence on October 18, is raising tensions on and around the Korean Peninsula, prompting Seoul to rapidly reassess its defence strategies in light of the potential direct threats to not only Ukraine but South Korea. As the South Korean government evaluates the implications for stability on the Korean Peninsula, it is also formulating its response in co-ordination with allies, including Canada.

The South Korean government is worried about North Korean troops gaining combat experience and acquiring advanced military knowledge from Russia. Seoul is exploring various options — including whether to provide lethal aid to Ukraine to help enhance its defence readiness — while collaborating with the U.S. and Japan to analyze the impact of North Korea's involvement in this conflict and develop a phased response strategy.

Canada, along with the U.S. and other NATO allies, strongly condemned the increasing military collaboration between North Korea and Russia, viewing the North Korean troop deployments as a violation of several UN Security Council resolutions. These countries are considering tightening sanctions against North Korea, increasing



Although Pyongyang and Moscow initially denied that North Korean troops were being sent to fight in the Russia-Ukraine conflict, a Russian official effectively acknowledged it at a recent meeting of the UN Security Council.

This deployment is enabled by the North Korea-Russia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership Treaty, signed in June 2024, which allows the two sides to provide military support to the other in the event of an attack. The treaty was unanimously ratified by Russia's State Duma on October 24, solidifying this military alliance. To try to conceal their presence, North Korean soldiers were reportedly issued forged identification documents resembling those of residents from Siberia's Yakutia and Buryatia regions.

their support for Ukraine, and re-evaluating their strategic postures, while NATO closely monitors the situation.

Implications

There are risks of a wider war. Analysts have described the deployment of North Korean troops to Russia as signalling a "hazardous new phase" in Russia-Ukraine war. The presence of these forces may prompt other countries to reconsider their positions, potentially igniting a chain reaction that further 'internationalizes' the war. There is also now a heightened risk of the conflict evolving into a proxy war involving North and South Korea. North Korean soldiers stand to gain real battlefield experience, and they may apply that combat experience on

the Korean Peninsula.

Kim Jong Un has received an economic lifeline from Russia — and possible military and diplomatic upgrades. South Korea's National Intelligence Service estimates that North Korean troops will receive C\$2,783 per soldier per month. With the U.S. Pentagon estimating troop levels at 10,000, the financial benefit to the Kim Jong Un regime could reach approximately C\$27.8 million per month, or roughly C\$334 million annually. These funds could alleviate some of the domestic economic pressures faced by North Korea, including the punishing effects of international sanctions, and fund further military development.

North Korean troops may gain access to advanced Russian military technology, enhancing their capabilities in areas such as drone warfare, electronic warfare, and modern artillery tactics. This exchange raises the possibility of Russia providing North Korea with sensitive military technology — such as satellite launch systems, nuclear submarine technology, and ballistic missile advancements — that Pyongyang has long sought to strengthen its strategic military assets. Diplomatically, Pyongyang can also use this contribution to Moscow's war effort as an opportunity to solidify its "blood alliance" with Russia, making the latter's security commitments to North Korea more binding demonstrating to South Korea and the U.S.

that its relationship with Moscow is a formidable one.

There is unease in Beijing over the deployment. China's concerns stem from the possibility that North Korea's actions could complicate regional dynamics and invite greater U.S. involvement in East Asia something Beijing very much wants to avoid. The U.S. has been urging China to pressure North Korea to pull its troops back, but even if Beijing were to comply and it seems very unlikely that it will there are questions as to whether Pyongyang would listen. The deepening of the North Korea-Russia alliance has already strained Pyongyang's relations with Beijing; China has removed several symbolic signs representing its amicable relationship with North Korea. Meanwhile, North Korea's foreign minister attended a ceremony in Moscow to unveil a plaque commemorating Kim Il Sung's first visit to the Soviet Union in 1949. Moreover, China's muted response to this latest turn of events reflects its apprehension that regional instability might threaten its own strategic interests, including stability along its northeastern border and influence over developments on the Korean Peninsula. At the same time, Beijing is unlikely to openly criticize North Korea or Russia, given its interest in Russia's resilience in Ukraine and the potential advantages of closer ties with both countries, considering its strategic rivalry with the U.S.

What's Next

Canada-South Korea Military Cooperation

Canada previously engaged in discussions with South Korea to purchase artillery shells to bolster Ukraine's defence capabilities. These discussions might resume as both countries seek to collaborate in addressing global security challenges. In their 2+2 foreign and defence ministers' meeting on November 1, the two countries launched an "Indo-Pacific Dialogue" to discuss cooperation and agreed to expedite negotiations for an intelligence-sharing pact.

South Korea's possible policy shift toward Russia

Seoul has tried to avoid a worsening of its relations with Moscow, not only in anticipation of an eventual end to the conflict but also due to its ongoing economic ties with Russia. However, this tightening of North Korea-Russia security ties could prompt South Korea to alter its foreign policy, which could mean reducing its dependence on Russian resources such as uranium, and more robust support for Ukraine.

South Korea sending independent observers

Seoul is considering dispatching observer teams in partnership with Ukraine and



NATO to monitor the situation, which could be an opportunity to gather intelligence on North Korean military equipment and combat tactics. Additionally, casualties among North Korean troops in Ukraine could be utilized in psychological operations against Pyongyang.

Moscow expects better US-Russia ties after the victory of Trump

While President Vladimir Putin has yet to officially congratulate Donald Trump on his U.S. presidential election victory, high-ranking officials in the Kremlin, Russian government, and Foreign Ministry privately expressed have cautious optimism.

Moscow views Trump's potential return to office as an opportunity to bolster Russia's nearly three-year campaign in Ukraine, challenge a weakened European Union, and possibly improve relations with Washington, according to seven senior officials and three Russian business leaders.

"For now, we'll continue advancing in Ukraine," a Russian government official stated, noting a goal to reach the administrative borders of Donetsk and Luhansk regions by January. "After that, we'll determine the next steps regarding Kherson," he added, referring to the Kyiv-held capital of the Kherson region, partially occupied by Russian forces. Some officials believe continued Russian advances could encourage the incoming U.S. administration to propose negotiations, expecting that Kyiv might also show more willingness for dialogue. "When Trump takes office and his team is in place, we can start consultations," another official suggested, adding that the current U.S. administration has no emissaries to approach Moscow for discussions.

Most sources in government and business believe a resolution to the war favoring Russia could be within reach, provided that "Ukraine, with U.S. help, acknowledges the current territorial realities," they suggested. Russian diplomats anticipate that Trump will eagerly seek negotiation opportunities in Ukraine and the Middle East, viewing these as potential foreign policy wins. "Trump might look to position

himself as a peacemaker, possibly eveing accolades like the Nobel Peace Prize," a Foreign Ministry insider commented, adding. "He's always driven by self-interest."

As the U.S. continued to tally votes, President Putin oversaw the launch of the Chukotka nuclear icebreaker remotely from his office. Kremlin officials intended this to highlight Russia's economic and technological prowess in the Arctic, though some admit that Putin's absence from the event in northern Russia reduced the PR impact. Throughout the U.S. campaign, Putin publicly favored President Joe Biden, although insiders claim this was a tactic to mislead observers and harm the Democratic candidate. In reality, the Kremlin was rooting for Trump's success.

advisor, secretary of state, and defense secretary. A government official expressed confidence in Vice President-Elect JD Vance, suggesting that "his involvement may bring rational actors into the team."

Dialogue between Russia and the U.S. is currently frozen, though a Russian diplomat cautiously predicts that some contact may resume. Moscow also plans to appoint a new ambassador to Washington following Trump's inauguration. However, diplomats hold no illusions that a full restoration of relations is imminent, given entrenched U.S. political views on Russia. Trump's inclination to scale back U.S. involvement in European security could favor Russia, as European nations may struggle to manage security independently, a diplomatic source remarked.



Officials are particularly optimistic about Trump's second term, as the Republicans may control both chambers of Congress, potentially reducing opposition from Democrats. "Without a divided government, there's less chance of sabotage from the Democrats," one source noted. However, the interim period before Trump's inauguration remains risky, with fears that the outgoing Biden administration could take bolder actions against Moscow. "The Democrats might push measures that complicate future dialogue, like approving American weapons for strikes deeper into Russian territory," a diplomatic source told The Moscow Times.

Moscow will closely observe Trump's cabinet selections in the coming months, focusing on key roles like national security

Kremlin officials showed enthusiasm for Trump's win but remained critical of the U.S. electoral system. "It's satisfying, as they tried to deny him victory in 2020," one official said, echoing conspiracy theories about election interference against Trump. Russian officials noted that they often find more common ground with Republicans, sharing similar values on issues like migration and traditionalism.

"I'm optimistic about normalizing international relations," another official said while acknowledging that Trump is part of the political system and that radical changes are unlikely. "If Harris had won, the military-industrial and pharmaceutical lobbies would have likely continued their influence unopposed," he added.

Monetary Policy Statement and its Impact on Economy and Inflation

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he Monetary Policy Committee ▲ (MPC) decided to cut the policy rate by 250 basis points to 15 percent, effective from November 5, 2024. The Committee noted that inflation has declined faster than expected and has reached close to its medium-term target range in October. The Committee assessed that the tight monetary policy stance continues to play an important role in sustaining the downward trend in inflation. Moreover, a sharp decline in food inflation, favorable global oil prices, and the absence of expected adjustments in gas tariffs and PDL rates have accelerated the pace of disinflation in recent months. Taking into account the inherent risks associated with these factors, the MPC assessed that the near-term inflation may remain volatile before stabilizing within the target range.

The Committee noted the following key developments since its last meeting that could have implications for the macroeconomic outlook. First, the IMF Board approved Pakistan's new EFF program, which has reduced uncertainty and improved the prospects for realization of planned external inflows. Second, the surveys conducted in October showed an improvement in confidence and a reduction in inflation expectations of both consumers and businesses. Third, the secondary market yields on government securities and KIBOR have declined substantially. Fourth, tax collection during the first four months of FY25 fell short of the target. Lastly, while global oil prices have exhibited significant volatility amidst escalating geopolitical tensions, prices of metals and agricultural products have increased notably.

Considering these developments, the Committee viewed the current monetary policy stance as appropriate to achieve the objective of price stability on a durable basis by maintaining inflation within the 5-7 percent target range. This will also support macroeconomic stability and help achieve economic growth on a sustainable basis.

Real Sector

The latest data showed a gradual pick-up in economic activity. The initial estimates of major Kharif crops turned out better than the MPC's earlier expectations. Higher-than-targeted estimates of rice and sugarcane production have more than offset the estimated shortfall in maize and cotton output. Moreover, the pace of industrial activity is gaining further traction. In particular, textile, food, automobile and allied industries have recorded significant growth during July-August 2024, which is expected to gain further momentum in the coming months. This assessment is supported by increasing imports of raw materials and machinery, improving business confidence, and easing financial conditions. Better prospects of commodity-producing sectors and inflationary pressures are also expected to support services sector. Overall, the MPC expects real GDP growth in FY25 to be better than its earlier assessment, while remaining in the range of 2.5 - 3.5percent.

External Sector

The current account posted a surplus for the second consecutive month in September 2024; narrowing the cumulative deficit to \$98 million in Q1-FY25. Despite a substantial increase in imports, robust workers' remittances and higher exports helped contain the deficit. On the financing side, foreign investment recorded a slight uptick in September. These developments, along with receipt of the first tranche under the IMF program, helped in further build-up of SBP's FX reserves to \$11.2 billion as on October 25, 2024. Going forward, imports are expected to pick up further amidst increasing economic activity. The MPC, nonetheless, assessed that relatively higher workers' remittances and exports will help keep the current account deficit within the projected range of 0 - 1 percent of GDP. This, together with the realization of planned official inflows, is expected to increase the SBP's FX reserves to around \$13 billion by June 2025.

Fiscal Sector

During Q1-FY25, the fiscal and primary balances posted surpluses of 1.4 percent and 2.4 percent of GDP, respectively. This improvement is mainly explained by record high SBP profit, which substantially increased the non-tax revenues. In contrast, the FBR tax collection fell short of the target during July-October. This implies that achieving the FY25 tax target will

require significantly higher growth going forward. On the expenditure side, lower interest payments are creating a sizable fiscal space that would help keep a check on the overall fiscal deficit. Meeting the targeted primary balance, however, would be challenging. The MPC emphasized the importance of continued fiscal consolidation to support macroeconomic stability and reiterated the need for fiscal reforms, focusing on broadening the tax base and curtailing PSEs' losses.

Money and Credit

The broad money (M2) growth increased slightly to 15.2 percent y/y as of October 25, with noticeable changes in its composition since the last MPC meeting. Specifically, the net budgetary borrowing from the banking system declined considerably, while banks' credit to the non-government sector increased. After the receipt of SBP profit, the government reduced its borrowing from banks and also initiated buy-back operations of its outstanding debt securities. This created additional room for banks to extend credit to the private sector. At the same time, there was a significant reduction in SBP's liquidity injections, which is reflected by a decline in outstanding stock of OMOs. On the liability side, deposits continued to remain the major driver of M2 growth. Going forward, the MPC viewed that demand for private sector credit may further pick up with easing financial conditions and an expected increase in economic activity. Furthermore, in the coming weeks, banks may also extend advances to avoid additional tax on non-compliance of Advances-to-Deposit ratio (ADR) thresholds.

Inflation

Since the last MPC meeting, inflation eased significantly and fell close to its medium-term target range. The headline inflation (y/y) dropped to 6.9 percent in September and 7.2 percent in October, from 9.6 percent in August 2024. Besides contained demand, improved domestic supply of key food commodities, benign global oil prices, and favorable base effect accelerated the pace of disinflation in recent months. The MPC noted that the continuation of these factors may bring inflation further down in the next few months. Moreover, underlying inflationary pressures continued to ease, as indicated by a relatively gradual decline in core inflation and moderation in inflation expectations. Considering these developments, the MPC now expects the average inflation for FY25 to be significantly lower than its previous forecast range of 11.5 - 13.5 percent. The Committee also assessed that this outlook is subject to multiple risks, such as escalation in the Middle East conflict, recurrence of food inflation pressures, ad hoc adjustments in administered prices, and implementation of contingency taxation measures to meet shortfalls in revenue.



Will Bitcoin hit the \$100K level in the coming days?

itcoin approached the \$90,000 mark B on Tuesday, fueled by optimism following Donald Trump's election as U.S. president with expectations that his administration may adopt crypto-friendly policies. The world's largest cryptocurrency became one of the most watched assets in the week since the election, hitting \$89,637 in Asian trading—a rise of over 25% since November 5.

Bitcoin's rally is paralleled by Tesla's surge, as Elon Musk's automaker gained nearly 40% since the election results, with investors betting that Trump's allies and business interests could benefit under his administration.

"This is a Trump-driven trade, given his supportive stance on the industry, which could boost demand for both crypto stocks and digital currencies themselves," said Nick Twidale, chief market analyst at ATFX Global in Sydney. Bitcoin was already trading near all-time highs when the election outcome was announced, creating what Twidale described as "clear skies" for further growth.

During his campaign, Trump voiced strong support for digital assets, pledging to make the U.S. the "crypto capital of the world" and even accumulate a national Bitcoin reserve. While the timeline and mechanics of such plans remain uncertain, the mere prospect has sparked speculative interest in crypto mining and trading stocks.

"This could prompt other nations to preempt the U.S. by acquiring Bitcoin themselves," said Matthew Dibb, chief investment officer at crypto asset manager Astronaut Capital. "It could also be a major catalyst for U.S.-listed Bitcoin mining companies, with potential for them to even be nationalized."

Crypto miner Riot Platforms saw a nearly 17% jump on Wall Street, with further gains after hours, while fellow miners MARA Holdings and CleanSpark surged close to 30%.

Meanwhile, software firm and Bitcoin investor MicroStrategy announced it had spent around \$2 billion on Bitcoin between October 31 and November 10, pushing its

stock up 26% with additional gains in after-hours trading. The rally extended across the crypto market, with smaller tokens like ether (ETH) and meme coin dogecoin (DOGE) also climbing. Crypto investors are hopeful for a reduction in regulatory pressures, as Trump has pledged to replace U.S. SEC Chair Gary Gensler. Trump also launched a crypto-focused venture, World Liberty Financial, in September.

"What we're witnessing is more than a price milestone; it's an indication that the market is embracing Bitcoin as a more stable, potentially politically favored asset," said Justin D'Anethan, head of Asia-Pacific business development at digital asset market maker Keyrock.

Meanwhile, the excitement around cryptocurrencies has returned, with Bitcoin prices surging this year and renewed interest from investors and media alike. For the average investor, a key question emerges: What has fundamentally shifted in the cryptocurrency space to drive Bitcoin's impressive 120% gain over the past twelve months? Additionally, the price increase has come with rising trading volumes, signaling robust buying interest.

The momentum doesn't seem to be slowing down. Speculation is growing that Bitcoin could soon surpass the \$100,000 mark—a significant jump from its current level of around \$80,000. Such a milestone would represent a massive increase, raising curiosity about whether Bitcoin's trajectory will follow the pattern of commodities like oil during the 2008-09 financial crisis, or whether it will chart a new course altogether.

The Broader Perspective

Pricing investment assets, especially cryptocurrencies, is complex and often doesn't conform to traditional demand-supply models. Like other assets, Bitcoin's price movements are influenced by perceptions of how specific news affects future user adoption and transaction volumes.

For Bitcoin, demand is primarily driven by two factors:

- 1. The number of active users.
- 2. Their transaction volumes.

On the supply side, Bitcoin's total supply is capped, with nearly 94% already mined, so demand—user growth and transaction volume—plays a central role in price dynamics.

What's Driving Demand?

A few major shifts seem to be fueling demand:

1. A Renewed View of Bitcoin as a Dollar Alternative

Amid concerns about the strength of the U.S. dollar, there's a growing belief that Bitcoin could serve as a dependable alternative currency and asset class.

2. Political Support for Cryptocurrency

Political support, notably from figures like Donald Trump and Kamala Harris, has bolstered confidence in the U.S. government's favorable stance toward Bitcoin and other digital assets. Historically, regulatory actions have had a significant impact on cryptocurrency prices, and recent stability in global policies adds further support.

3. Institutional Interest, Led by Blackrock's Spot Bitcoin ETF

Institutional interest has reassured retail investors, with Blackrock's spot Bitcoin ETF emerging as one of the fastest-growing funds. This ETF has bolstered confidence in Bitcoin as a long-term asset while increasing open positions and user activity—both demand-positive factors.

Is Bitcoin an Attractive **Buy Now?**

Bitcoin's performance has been volatile: it gained 60% in 2021, dropped 64% in 2022, and soared 155% in 2023. This volatility is in stark contrast to portfolios like Trefis' High Quality (HQ) Portfolio, a collection of 30 stocks that have consistently outperformed the S&P 500 with less risk and volatility.

Given these demand-supply dynamics, Bitcoin's outlook for the next 12 months remains uncertain. Will it continue its climb toward \$100,000 or settle as an underperforming asset?

Why the \$100,000 Mark **Matters**

Interest in Bitcoin options with a \$100,000 strike price has surged, with a rise in open interest suggesting upward momentum. While some positions are speculative, this interest indicates that many investors expect Bitcoin's price to rise. In the meantime, Bitcoin must clear resistance levels at \$70k, \$80k, and \$90k, each of which could bring more volatility. If demand remains strong, Bitcoin may eventually surpass the \$100,000 mark, although the road may be

Bitcoin surpasses \$80K

Bitcoin surged to a record high on Sunday as traders speculated that Donald Trump's potential return to the White House could boost the cryptocurrency sector. The digital currency crossed the \$80,000 mark for the first time in its history shortly after noon.

Since Trump's victory in last Tuesday's U.S. presidential election, Bitcoin has been on the rise amid optimism that the Republican candidate will relax regulations on digital currencies.

Bitcoin climbed to \$75,000 on Wednesday, surpassing its previous all-time high of \$73,797.98 set in March. In the race against Democratic candidate Kamala Harris, Trump was widely regarded as the pro-crypto candidate.

Although Trump had previously criticized cryptocurrencies as a scam during his first presidency, he has since reversed his stance, even launching his digital currency platform.

Trump has promised to establish the United States as the "bitcoin and cryptocurrency capital of the world" and has pledged to appoint tech billionaire Elon Musk to lead a comprehensive audit of government waste. His previous term was marked by corporate tax cuts that injected liquidity into markets, spurring investments in high-growth assets like cryptocurrencies. In September, Trump announced the upcoming launch of World Liberty Financial, a digital currency platform co-founded with his sons and business partners.

However, the platform's token sale earlier this month saw limited demand, with only a small portion of tokens finding buyers. Cryptocurrencies have been known for their volatility and high-profile scandals, including the collapse of major industry players like the FTX exchange.

Leading up to the election, Trump reportedly became the first former president to use Bitcoin in a transaction, purchasing burgers at a New York City restaurant that celebrated the sale as a "historic transaction." Bitcoin trading remains active around the clock, including Sundays.

Standard Chartered prediction of Ethereum and Bitcoin prices

In a bold new forecast, Standard Chartered has projected that Ethereum could reach \$10,000 in the near term, fueling optimism amid a strong crypto rally. The report also suggests that Bitcoin may follow suit with an impressive run towards the \$200,000

mark. This prediction aligns with recent momentum in the digital assets space, especially following Donald Trump's election victory and the recent 25 basis points rate cut by the Federal Reserve.

Standard Chartered **Predicts Ethereum Will** Reach \$10,000

According to Standard Chartered, the overall cryptocurrency market cap could see a fourfold increase by the U.S. mid-term elections in 2026. Currently, at around \$2.5 trillion, this would imply a future market cap of approximately \$10 trillion. Additionally, the firm reiterated its target of \$10,000 for Ethereum, expecting it to hit this level by late 2025, a forecast that has bolstered market confidence in the ongoing rally.

echoed this sentiment, stating that Ethereum's recent rise to \$3,000 is "just the beginning" of a larger bull run. He previously noted that Ethereum might follow a similar trajectory to the S&P 500 and reach the \$10,000 mark shortly.

What's the Next for ETH and BTC?

The bank also reaffirmed its prediction that Bitcoin would hit \$200,000 alongside Ethereum's \$10,000 target. According to Standard Chartered, Bitcoin and major altcoins, including Solana and Ethereum, are well-positioned to benefit under the new administration.

The firm also considers the possibility—albeit slim-that the U.S. might adopt Bitcoin as a national strategic reserve,



Standard Chartered Head of Research, Geoffrey Kendrick, highlighted factors such as the recent Republican win and anticipated regulatory clarity as reasons for his bullish forecast. He believes Trump's presidency could foster crypto-friendly policies, potentially accelerating digital asset adoption.

Moreover, Standard Chartered anticipates that the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) will adopt a more lenient stance on the crypto market under Republican leadership. This speculation is further fueled by reports suggesting that SEC Chair Gary Gensler may step down soon, which has sparked discussions around potential regulatory shifts.

Prominent crypto analyst Ali Martinez

which could further support the crypto's growth. Trump previously suggested he would consider Bitcoin as a reserve, and Senator Cynthia Lummis has also endorsed this idea.

Today, Bitcoin's price rose by 0.3% to \$76,532, after reaching a 24-hour high of \$77,252. Increased inflows into U.S. Spot Bitcoin ETFs also reflect rising institutional support for the asset.

In another positive development, fresh wallets are accumulating Bitcoin, indicating strong demand among retail and institutional traders. Crypto analyst Ali Martinez highlighted that over 57,800 BTC-valued at approximately \$4.16 billion—has been accumulated over the past few days, further boosting investor sentiment.

Zaka emphasized that these skills are essential for achieving financial independence in the volatile world of digital assets. He assured followers that similar trading opportunities would arise in the future.

What is Leverage **Trading?**

For newcomers, leverage trading is a strategy that allows investors to control larger sums of money by borrowing funds based on their original capital. This leverage is often represented in ratios, like 5:1 or 5x, meaning a trader can control a position five times their initial investment. In Zaka's case, 200x leverage allowed him to control a position worth 200 times his capital, creating a scenario of heightened returns and risks.

Quetta Railway Station Suicide bombing: Is it a security failure?

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suicide bombing at a crowded railway station in Quetta, the capital of Pakistan's volatile Balochistan province, has killed at least 26 people and left more than 60 others injured. The attack, which took place on November 8, 2024, occurred around 8:45 a.m. local time while nearly 100 passengers were waiting for a train to Peshawar. According to Wasim Baig, a spokesperson for the Balochistan health department, the death toll from the powerful blast has now risen to 26, with many others critically injured. The blast opened a fresh debate _ Is it a security failure?

Among the dead were over a dozen soldiers and six railway employees. The explosion left 62 people injured, several of whom are in serious condi-

Balochistan, Pakistan's largest and most impoverished province, has long been a hotspot for violence. The region is rich in natural resources, but separatist groups, including the Balochistan Liberation Army (BLA), have repeatedly targeted military and civilian infrastructure in their struggle for independence. The BLA, which has been designated a terrorist group by Pakistan, the U.S., and the U.K., claimed responsibility for the attack, stating that a suicide bomber targeted security forces stationed at the railway station.

Balochistan has witnessed a sharp increase in violence in 2024, with a rising number of attacks on security forces. This bombing marks the first major attack in central Quetta, raising concerns among local residents and officials. Journalist Saadullah Akhter. who witnessed the aftermath, described the attack as "shocking," noting the surge in violence across the province, but emphasizing that such an attack in the heart of Quetta is unprecedented.

Shahid Rind, a provincial government spokesperson, confirmed that the bombing appeared to have been a suicide attack, although investigations are still ongoing to verify the claim by the BLA. Security forces continue to gather evidence at the site, where footage showed bloodied clothing and personal items scattered across the platform, and the steel structure of the platform's roof torn apart by the explosion.

Balochistan, which borders both Afghanistan and Iran, remains a volatile region with ongoing conflicts driven by ethnic separatist movements, competing political interests, and the exploitation of the province's rich natural resources.

In a statement following the bombing, Prime Minister Shehbaz expressed deep sorrow over the tragic loss of life and extended his condolences to the families of the victims. He stressed the importance of providing immediate medical care to the wounded and vowed that those responsible for targeting innocent civilians would be held accountable and face the full force of the law.

Prime Minister Sharif also called for swift action and a thorough investigation to ensure that the perpetrators are brought to justice. Political leaders across the country have united in their condemnation of the attack, underscoring the need to maintain stability and security in Pakistan despite the ongoing threats of terrorism.

Acting President Yousuf Raza Gilani also condemned the attack, labeling the perpetrators as "enemies of humanity" for deliberately harming innocent

people. He reaffirmed the government's firm commitment to fighting terrorism and pledged to take all necessary actions to completely eliminate such threats.


National Assembly Speaker Ayaz Sadiq expressed his solidarity with the grieving families, condemning the attackers as ruthless enemies of humanity. He offered his support to those affected by the tragedy, emphasizing the need for unity and compassion during such a difficult time.

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif vowed that those responsible for the attack "will pay a very heavy price." Balochistan province, where separatist movements have long been active.

However, the government's military operations to suppress these separatist movements in Balochistan have raised serious concerns about human rights abuses. Over the years, there have been numerous reports of enforced disappearances, torture, and extrajudicial killings targeting Baloch activists and dissenters. These actions have sparked criticism from both local and international human rights organizations, which accuse the Pakistani military of using heavy-handed tactics in its efforts to quell opposition in the region.

Interior Minister Mohsin Nagvi condemned the bombing as a "cowardly" Ulema Council chairman Hafiz Tahir Ashrafi, condemned the bombing. Ashrafi further suggested that the Pakistani government review its Afghan policy to ensure that Pakistan's "goodwill is not misused."

The tension in Balochistan reflects a deep-rooted conflict over the province's wealth of natural resources, with Baloch nationalist groups arguing that the central government unfairly exploits the region's gas, oil, and mineral reserves while providing little benefit to the local population. The military crackdown, which is part of Islamabad's strategy to suppress separatist movements, has further alienated many in Balochistan, fueling resentment and calls for independence.

World leaders condemn suicide bombing at **Quetta railway station**

The suicide bombing in Quetta has drawn widespread condemnation from political, religious, and international leaders across the globe.

Russian President Vladimir Putin

In a letter of condolence, Russian President Vladimir Putin expressed his deep sorrow over the tragedy, which claimed the lives of several civilians, including women and children, and left many others injured. He strongly condemned the "barbaric crime" and called for justice for those responsible. Putin emphasized Russia's solidarity with Pakistan in the fight against terrorism, reaffirming his country's commitment to working closely with Pakistani authorities to combat extremism and protect citizens from violent attacks. "We are determined to continue our close cooperation with our Pakistani partners against all forms and manifestations of terrorism," Putin wrote.

The US Mission to Pakistan also expressed its condolences, assuring the Pakistani government of its full support in the fight against terrorism. In a statement, the mission said: "We extend our deepest condolences to the victims and their families. We will continue to stand by Pakistan in preventing such acts of terrorism against civilians and soldiers."

Malaysian PM conveys sympathies

Malaysian Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim conveyed his heartfelt sympathies, writing on X: "On behalf of Malaysia, I extend our deepest condolences to the people of Pakistan, who mourn this senseless and devastating loss." He emphasized Malaysia's steadfast solidarity with Pakistan in its ongoing fight against terrorism.

Turkey also condemned the terrorist attack, with the Turkish Ministry of Foreign Affairs extending condolences to Pakistan and wishing a swift recovery to those injured. "We will continue to support Pakistan in its fight against terrorism," the ministry stated.

UK calls it divisive act

The United Kingdom's High Commissioner to Pakistan, Jane Marriott, called the bombing "horrific" and noted that such acts sow division within society. "My sympathies are with the families of the victims and the injured," Marriott said, adding that the UK stands firmly with Pakistan in condemning terrorism and supporting its efforts to combat extremism and violence.

UN chief slams attack

UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres condemned the "heinous" attack, calling for the perpetrators to be held accountable. He expressed condolences to the families of the victims, as well as to the people and government of Pakistan. Guterres also wished a speedy recovery for the injured, stressing that those responsible must be brought to justice.

This broad international and domestic condemnation highlights the global consensus on the need to combat terrorism and reaffirmed Pakistan's determination to confront these violent threats.

The Rise of the Baloch Liberation Army in Pakistan

Aziz Baloch, an independent security expert in Balochistan, noted that the Baloch Liberation Army (BLA) is determined to show that it can "demoralize the [Pakistani] Army" and assert itself as the "dominant militant group" in the region.

Balochistan has been plagued by a low-level insurgency and a harsh military crackdown for decades. The BLA, alongside other separatist groups in the region, seeks independence from Pakistan, accusing the government of exploiting the province's rich natural resources and committing serious human rights abuses.

The BLA is the largest armed group in Balochistan, with experts estimating it has several thousand members. This year, researchers have noted a sharp uptick in attacks carried out by Baloch separatist groups.

Enhanced Capabilities and Deadlier Tactics

Experts believe the BLA has become more

organized and increasingly dangerous. Following the U.S. withdrawal from Afghanistan in 2021, militant groups, including the BLA, reportedly seized large quantities of American weapons and military equipment left behind by U.S. and international forces. These weapons have significantly improved the BLA's combat capabilities.

Aziz Baloch, the journalist, pointed out that the BLA, although a secular group, has begun adopting tactics typically associated with Islamist militant groups like the Afghan Taliban and the Tehrik-e Taliban Pakistan (TTP), such as suicide bombings, improvised explosive devices (IEDs), and complex attacks involving multiple assailants and vehicle-borne IEDs. The BLA's Majeed Brigade, its suicide squad, is thought to have carried out many of these complex attacks.

unemployment, political repression, and reports of state abuses have made the region a "fertile ground" for the BLA's recruitment efforts. Many of the group's leaders and fighters come from educated backgrounds, including former professionals and university students.

Pakistan's response to the Baloch insurgency has largely been one of military force, with little effort to address the long-standing grievances of the Baloch people. Aziz Baloch argued that the BLA represents the state's failure to govern Balochistan effectively.

Abdul Malik Baloch, former chief minister of Balochistan, said that growing disillusionment with Islamabad's political interference has fueled support for the insurgency. He cited the rigging of elections in Balochistan as a key factor in the erosion



In 2022, the BLA saw a significant shift when a 31-year-old mother became the first woman to carry out a suicide bombing for the group, a move that some observers described as a "paradigm shift."

Exploiting Local Discontent

Local socio-economic conditions have also played a role in strengthening the BLA. Balochistan's population is largely young, with around 65 percent of its 15 million people under the age of 30. This youthful demographic has been a primary target for BLA recruitment, and the group has even attracted female recruits.

Balochistan's widespread poverty, high

of trust in the political system. "Many Baloch see democracy as a fraud," Baloch remarked. "They feel their time is being wasted."

Opposition leaders have accused Pakistan's powerful military of rigging the parliamentary elections, further alienating the population. Why do Nations fail?

istory is full of countless civilizations, changed history through success while others failed to survive. Why? Why do many nations throughout history fail at stability, success, or progress? It is a complex interplay of factors—weak institutions, entrenched corruption, widening inequality, and failure to adapt to changing global dynamics—that drives nations toward crisis and decline. In their book Why Nations Fail, economists Daron Acemoglu and James A. Robinson argue that nations fail not because of geography, climate, or culture but largely due to political and economic institutions. According to their thesis, inclusive institutions encourage prosperity, while extractive institutions lead to poverty and decline. Understanding why nations fail is essential, as it reveals lessons not just about history but about the choices that build or break societies.

The downfall of nations is rarely caused by a single event or an instant outplay, instead, it's a disaster that's slowly built from root problems that began often as far back as the creation of the nation. Venezuela is an excellent example of this, a nation so rich in oil yet still a failed state. It wasn't always

like that, at one point Venezuela was a rich and developed land full of growth and harmony yet the issue was that Venezuela built its entire economy on a single thing: oil and when it collapsed so did the country.

Unraveling the Causes of National Decline

Building or Breaking a Nation

Institutions are the frameworks within which economic, political, and social activities occur, and they play a critical role in shaping a nation's future. Inclusive institutions empower a broad segment of the population to participate in economic and political life, enabling innovation, productivity, and shared prosperity. On the other hand, extractive institutions concentrate power and wealth among a few, stifling growth and creating social tensions that often lead to decline.

For example, consider South Korea and North Korea. These two nations share a common history and culture, yet their fates diverged dramatically due to differences in governance.
